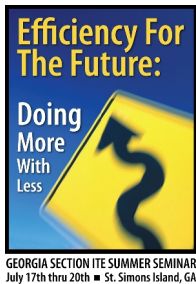

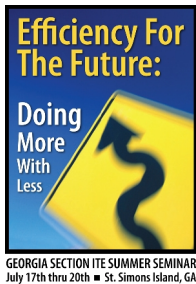

Conference Registration Information

Please register for the 2011 Georgia ITE Summer Seminar by downloading the one-page registration form. It can be found on the 2011 Summer Seminar conference webpage at http://www.gaite.org/2011_SummerSeminar.html, or download directly at: <http://www.gaite.org/docs/GASITE%20Summer%20Session%20Registration%20Form.xls>.

On the left side of the form, fill out the usual registrant and guest info, and select from the drop-down menu whether you are an ITE Member (with 2011 dues paid), a non-member or student. Attendee and student registration includes admission to all technical sessions, the Sunday evening Welcome Reception, a Monday buffet breakfast, the Volleyball tournament, and the Tuesday evening Banquet and dessert social. Spouse/guest and children registration includes admission to the Sunday Welcome Reception, the Bowling Tournament, the Sandcastle Competition and the Tuesday evening Banquet and Dessert Social. New this year, there will be a \$5 admission fee to the Tuesday evening Scholarship Reception/Auction (cash at the door) that will be credited to any purchases made at the auction.

Meal and drink tickets will be issued for all attendees, students, spouses, guests and their children for the Sunday Welcome Reception and Tuesday Banquet. Please be sure to indicate how many of each will attend each event. Tickets will be issued for the Monday buffet breakfast to conference registrants. Meal tickets will NOT be issued for spouses, guests or their children for the Monday Buffet Breakfast; however, family and friends may pay the hotel separately for the buffet breakfast. The Monday buffet breakfast tickets can only be used between 7:00 and 8:30am. All late comers after 8:30 am are responsible for their own breakfast on Monday.

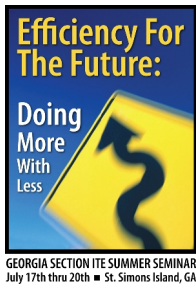
On the right side of the form, indicate the events you and/or your guest(s)/children will be participating in, including the Sunday reception and Tuesday banquet meals. The opening reception on Sunday is a buffet meal for both adults and children to attend. For the Tuesday Banquet, each registrant and spouse/guest adult must select a meal choice. Children between 2 and 12 are invited to a pizza and movie party (with complementary baby-sitting service) from 5:30 to 9:30pm, and afterwards will re-join parents for a desert and dancing social.

You can also sign up for the golf outing (and sponsor if you wish), water park, 5k walk/run and bowling events. A ticket for the Port of Brunswick charter bus tour is included for only the registrant. Please sign up (or decline) for either Tour 1 (early morning) or Tour 2 (mid-morning) opposite technical sessions 4A or 5A. Each bus holds 56 passengers and it's first -come first-serve for each time slot. A box breakfast or lunch is included on the tour.

2011 Summer Seminar Technical Paper Competition – Call for Abstracts

As part of the Summer Seminar, we're holding a Technical Paper Competition. If you have not written a paper before, this is your chance to write and win (and offset the gas expenditures to get to St. Simons Island!) If writing your own paper sounds intimidating or daunting, consider co-writing a paper. Martin Bretherton and Keith Strickland co-wrote the winning paper for the 2011 Winter Workshop.

Those wishing to publish a technical paper should submit an **Abstract** of no more than 200 words to Winter Horbal, Vice Chair of the Technical Committee, at wghorbal@foresitegroupinc.com by 5:00pm **Friday, May 13th, 2011**. Your **Final Paper** will be due to Winter Horbal (via e-mail) by 5:00pm on **Friday July 1st, 2011**.

The competition is open to all transportation professionals and university students. As a guideline, papers should be between 5-15 pages in length. Judging will be led by the Section's Technical Committee. The papers will be judged based on three criteria:

- best technically
- helps promote the profession
- relevant topic for ITE membership

Monetary awards will be presented (based on whether the papers are judged worthy) as follows:

- 1st place \$600
- 2nd place \$300
- 3rd place \$100

Competition results and checks for the winners will be presented at the Summer Seminar in St. Simons July 17-21, 2011. The 1st place winner will have the opportunity to present their paper at a future conference.
